Instructions to the candidates:

1. All the candidates who have been allotted a seat for B Tech Programme in NITK Surathkal in JoSAA Rounds and have secured their seat at NITK by paying the Partial Admission Fee during 19-21 October 2022 at the JoSAA portal.

OR

- 2. Those candidates who may be allotted a seat for B.Tech Programme in NITK Surathkal in CSAB Special Rounds 1 and 2, and have secured their seat at NITK by paying the CSAB special round enrollment fee.
- 3. The login credentials for NITK IRIS admission portal https://iris.nitk.ac.in/admission/admissions/login will be sent to candidates by email on <u>4th November 2022</u>.

Candidates are advised to fill their details through the NITK IRIS portal on clicking the MIS link and pay the balance Institute's fee / Hostel's Fee before final physical reporting for admission to the institute. The amount of fee to be paid at IRIS portal will be notified at a later date. (If it is not possible to fill-in the details and pay the fees before reaching NITK, arrangements will be made to use the computer facilities at NITK.)

The classes for first semester B.Tech students for the academic year 2022-23 would commence from November 14, 2022. The orientation programme will be held from 10th November, 2022 onwards. The schedule for the same will be notified at a later date.

The Academic Calendar will be made available in the Institute website soon.

Hostel Facility

Hostel facilities are available to all the students. Hostel Room Allotment will be done to the admitted students during physical reporting and they may occupy the hostel rooms.

The following documents to be uploaded in the IRIS portal and original along with two photocopies to be submitted for verification during physical reporting for admission.

- 1. Provisional admission letter downloaded from the JoSAA portal, after paying the partial admission fee, between October 19 21, 2022 or that downloaded from CSAB portal after payment of seat enrollment fee as applicable.
- 2. Score Card of JEE (Main)
- 3. Admit Card of JEE (Main)
- 4. Original Certificate of Date of Birth issued by competent authority/Class X (High School) Board Certificate as proof of date of birth
- 5. Original Mark sheet of Class XII
- 6. Original Certificate of category (OBC-NCL/SC/ST), if applicable, as per Government of India, issued by the competent authority. In case of OBC category, the certificate must be issued on or after April 1, 2022.
- 7. OBC Undertaking in the format available in NITK Website
- 8. Original Income and Asset Certificate for EWS candidates, if applicable, as per Government of India, issued by the competent authority. The certificate must be issued on or after April 1, 2022.
- 9. Original Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PWD), if applicable, issued by the competent authority and the physical verification report issued by any verifying center during JoSAA Rounds.
- 10. Original Migration certificate of last institute/university attended (If from outside Karnataka)
- 11. Original Conduct/Character Certificate from head of the institution last attended
- 12. Original Transfer certificate from the head of the institution last attended
- 13. Medical Fitness Certificate. (format available in NITK Website)
- 14. Photo ID proof as per Govt. of India norms (Copy of Aadhar Card is compulsory)
- 15. Passport size photograph.

(If any certificate is in language other than Hindi or English or Kannada, translation of the same in English is to be produced with certification by the competent authority).

Important Note:

- (1) Candidates belonging to OBC –NCL or EWS category are required to submit the certificates in the prescribed format available in the NITK website (i.e. <u>www.nitk.ac.in</u>) or in JoSAA portal and issued on or after April 1, 2022
- (2) Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra State must be validated by Social Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL category) and Tribal Welfare department (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government. The SC/ST/OBC-NCL candidates of Maharashtra State have to produce their caste validity certificate in the format available in the NITK website (i.e. <u>www.nitk.ac.in</u>).
- (3) The candidates who belong to PWD category must submit the certificate issued from a competent authority in the prescribed format.
